

APPLICATION FOR EFCE INSTITUTIONAL MEMBERSHIP

Institutional Membership is open to European and Non-European institutions and corporate bodies whose activities relate to the field of chemical and biochemical engineering sciences and which meet the conditions and obligations of Institutional Membership as set out in this constitution and as determined under the rules from time to time and which are accepted for Institutional Membership by the EFCE charity trustees. EFCE Institutional Membership is free of charge.

Institutional Members have a right to:

- be represented in the General Assembly without voting rights; receive agenda and minutes of meetings of the General Assembly;
- receive current information via the EFCE's news and press releases;
- propose nominees for medals awarded by the EFCE and for Honorary Membership.

They shall ensure that their individual members are aware of the activities of the EFCE and that the EFCE is informed about their activities in chemical engineering such as events in their countries that would be of importance to other EFCE members.
