2017 EFCE Student Mobility Award announced

For the sixth time, the European Federation of Chemical Engineering (EFCE) is pleased to announce its prestigious **Student Mobility Award**.

Designed to promote mobility among European chemical engineering students, the award is presented every two years to the best European students of chemical engineering who have spent one or more semesters studying abroad.

The EFCE Student Mobility Award 2017 will consist of three prizes:

1st Prize: €2,000; 2nd Prize: €1,500; 3rd Prize: €1,000.

The prizes will be awarded during the 10th World Congress of Chemical Engineering - WCCE10 (www.wcce10.org), incorporating the 11th European Congress of Chemical Engineering (ECCE11) and the 3rd European Congress of Applied Biotechnology (ECAB4), which will be held in Barcelona, Spain, from 1 to 5 October 2017. The Student Mobility Award also includes an invitation to the World Congress and a travel grant of up to €500.

Any student who is a citizen of a European country in which EFCE is represented can apply for the EFCE Student Mobility Award if they have successfully studied for at least one semester (≥ 30 ECTU) in first or second cycle study programmes in chemical engineering in each of two or more different countries.

All documents should be submitted in *English* no later than 2 years after graduation.

The deadline for submission of applications is 28 February 2017.
